

Stormwater Pollution Reporting

Please report all pollution concerns to the City of Round Rock, Williamson County, or the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), especially if any such concern has the potential to impact a stream, creek, or other nearby water sources. Complainants may remain anonymous, if requested.

Pollution concerns, illicit discharges, and/or illegal dumping can be reported to the following authorities:
