# EXAMPLES OF ILLICIT DISCHARGES

- Illegal dumping into the storm drain
- Improper disposal of commercial or industrial waste
- Sewage or septic discharges
- Construction site runoff
- Improper Disposal of trash, pool water, household chemicals, motor oils, mechanical fluids, etc.
- Grass clippings and vegetative debris

Any discharge to the storm sewer system that is not composed entirely of stormwater is considered an illicit discharge. Stormwater runoff from urbanized areas can transfer pollutants into the storm sewer system that discharges into lakes and creeks.
